LETTER FROM DR. ROSS

Dear Friends and Families.

On March 11, 2025 the world lost Junior Bridgeman who died unexpectedly while speaking at a charity event. A beautiful silent leader lost a husband. Three phenomenal human beings lost a father. Hundreds of local leaders lost their mentor, and we all lost a hero.

Do you ever get to meet a hero in real life? There is a quote that says, "Humility and reverence will make you both wise and honored." When I first met Mr. Bridgemen I was deeply impressed by his thoughtful listening skills, his humble approach, and his insightful advice. I was blown away that a man with his history and legacy could be so down to earth. Our meeting left an impact on me. How could a man that had accomplished so much and blessed so many listen so intentionally to what I had to say? Yet, he did.

What I am only now beginning to realize is how much of the impact this man left on the world.

When West End School opened in 2005, Co-founder and Board Chair, Paul Perconti, asked Mr. Bridgeman to be an Inaugural Board Member. With his heart for service, he accepted. Since that time, his wisdom, leadership, and kindness have left an indelible mark on our organization.

The family knew how much West End School meant to Junior and in an unexpected surprise, named West End School in his obituary.

Since that time, tributes have been rolling into our school that echo this man's amazing legacy. Many of the gifts include written tributes that attempt to describe the impact Junior had on their lives and organization. Reading through the comments on these tributes, plus seeing various comments made in news articles and media have allowed me to better understand the scope of his impact as it seems hundreds if not thousands have told stories of their interactions with Mr. Bridgeman. Everyone from Shaquille O'Neal to Charles Barkley not only adored him, but sought him out as a mentor.

One person summed up their experience by saying "I have never met anyone more like Christ."

There are no words to describe how much he will be missed. My goal is to make him proud by positively impacting the city of Louisville, which we all know he loved, by changing the trajectory of the beautiful and brilliant young minds here in the West End. Our school will serve as a beacon of light continuing the work of Junior Bridgeman, by choosing to make the world a better place. May we all try to emulate his heart of service.








Pre-K is learning how to use technology for education.








"Make It Work" hands on inquiry exploring how electrical devices work. In this activity scholars had to use a wire, a battery, and a lightbulb to make the bulb light up.
